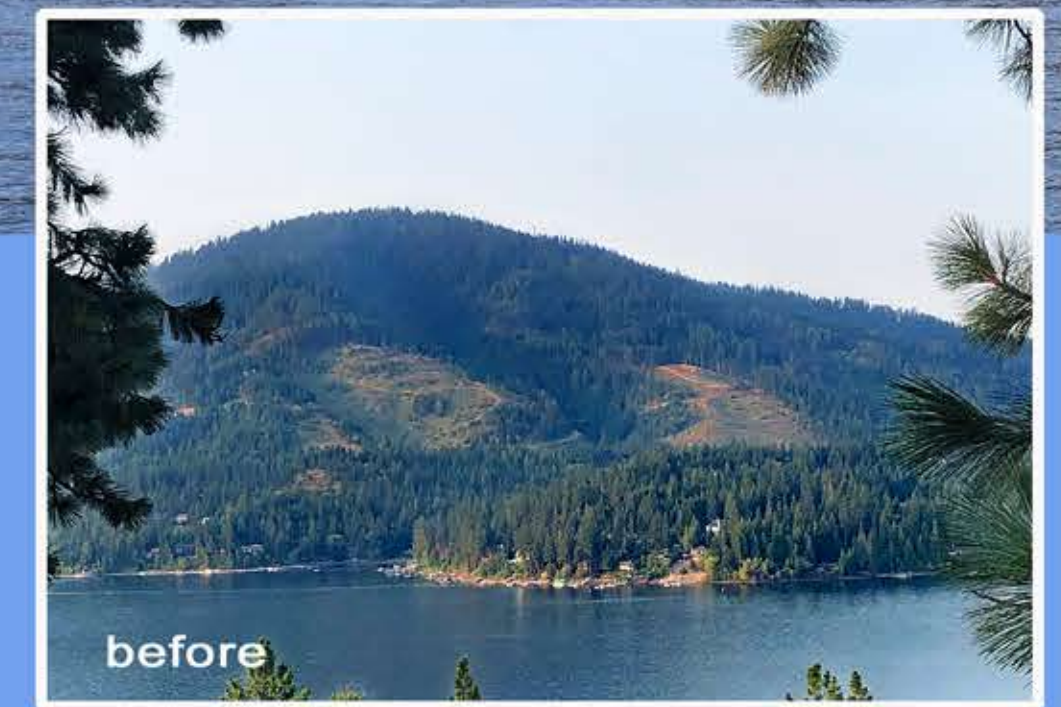
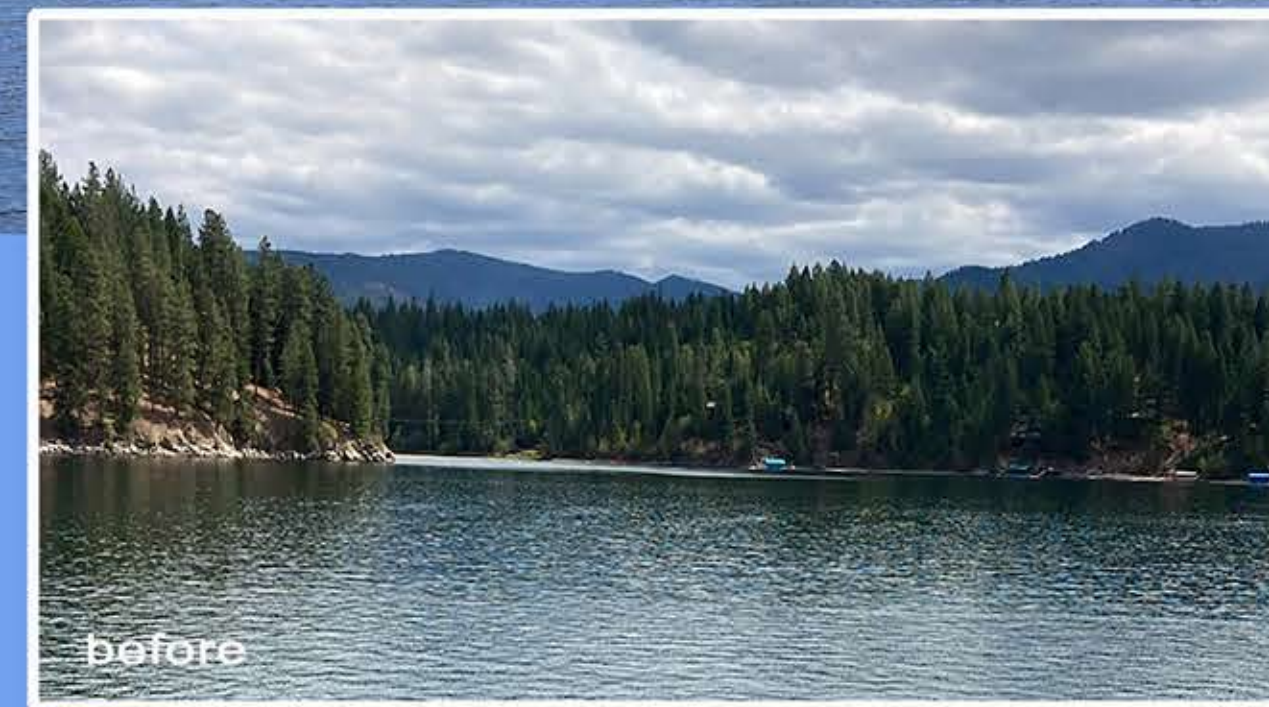
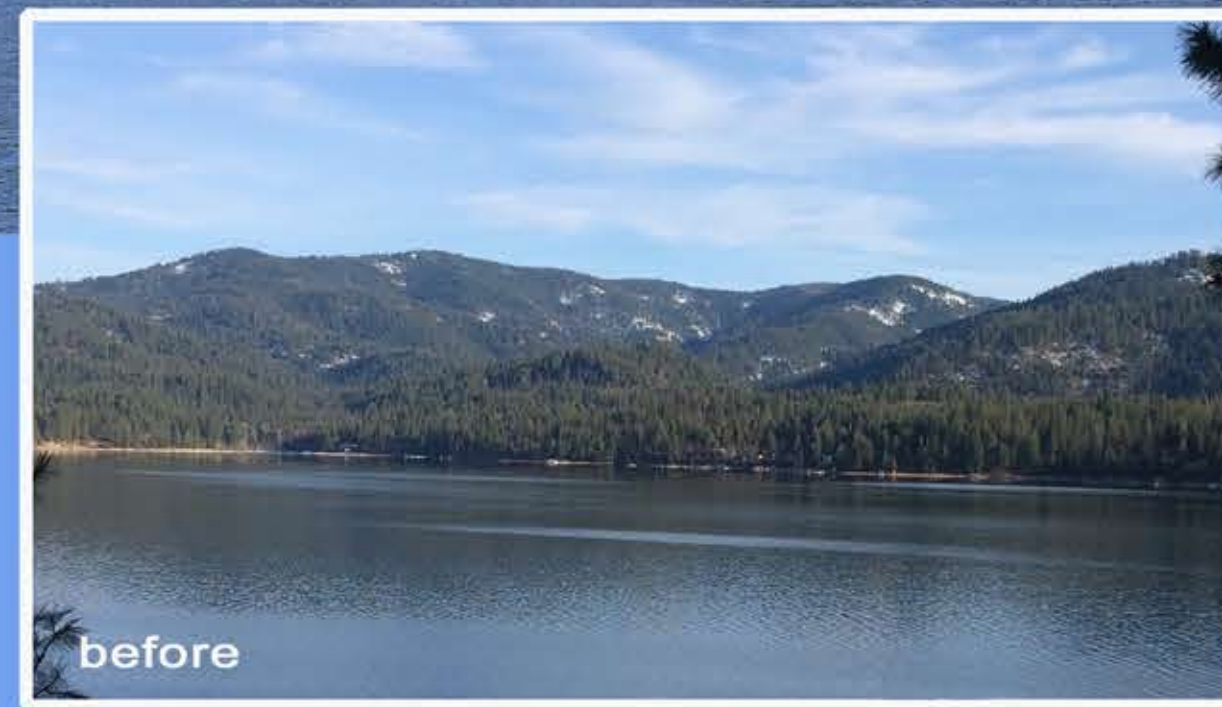
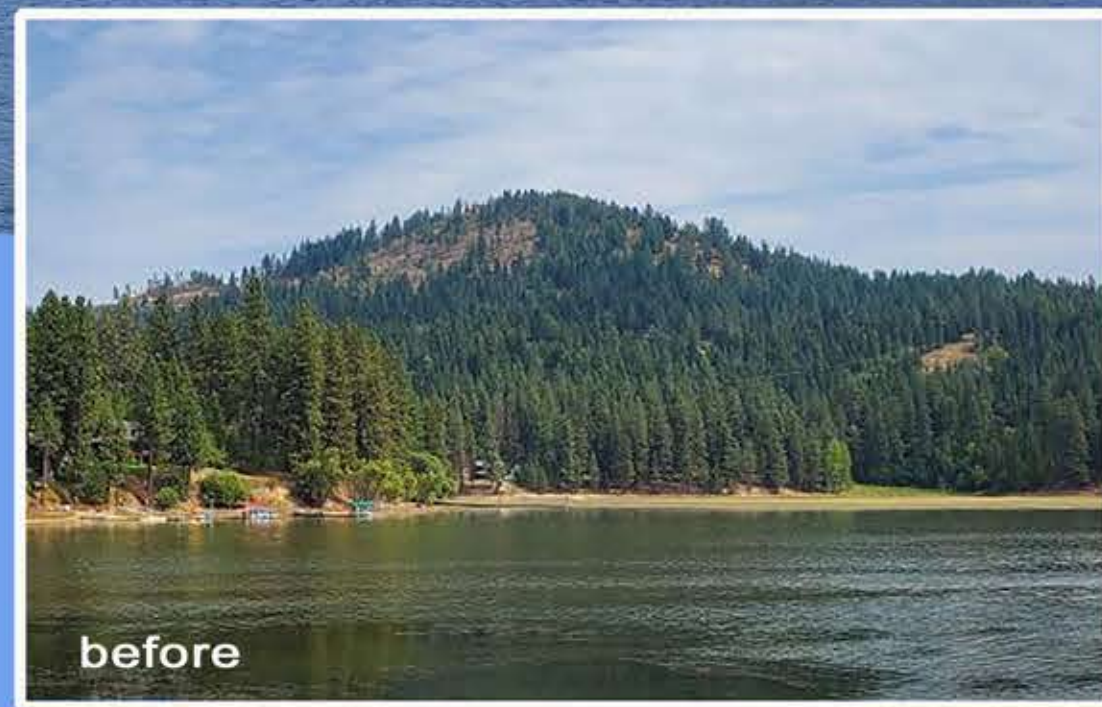
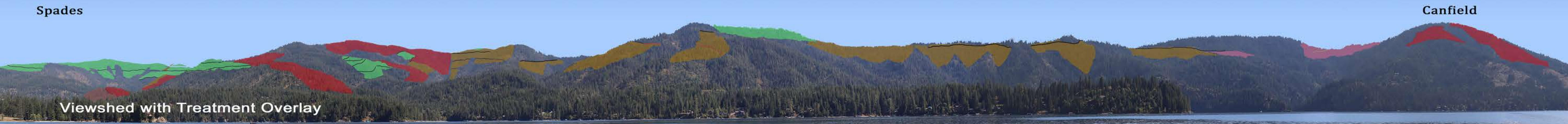


USFS Honey Badger Project Objectives:

- to improve forest health and increase resiliency to fire, insects, diseases, and drought.
- to maintain or improve water quality and aquatic species habitat.
- to reduce the potential for high intensity wildfire and promote desirable fire behavior and fuel conditions.
- to develop, restore and maintain recreation trails.

Treatment Types:

Landscape Burn

- blackened ground surfaces,
no change to tree density

Shelterwood Removed

- leaves an open stand with wide
spacing between trees

Seed-Trees Cut

- 10-20% trees remain in groups

Clearcut

- only a few trees remain
