  - '22-'23 monitoring objectives: characterize water quality in Windy and Berven Bays; follow up on '21's anomalous P concentration in Mokins Bay; extend mid-lake monitoring to statistically distinguish TP change
    - TY requested an assessment of monitoring results wrt Idaho Drinking Water Standards and TMDL Standards.
  - '22-'23 monitoring conclusions: the main body of HL remains oligotrophic with low TP; Mokins, Windy, and Berven Bays reflect the main body; HL is in a good position to absorb increased P and N nutrients.
  - GH recommendations: HL is sufficiently characterized via this study; do not recommend additional monitoring; recommend a full summary report of the full study.
- English Point Trail System improvement proposal, requesting HLWID letter of support and financial contribution (G Harvey). View the presentation.

- Friends of North Idaho Trails is applying for a Non-motorized Recreational Trails Program Grant to repair drainage issues throughout the English Point Trail System.
